

The Will of Abbis Worland (1781 - 1839)

Worland Abbis late  
of Meldreth Cow Leach deceased

This is the last Will and Testament  
of me Abbis Worland of Meldreth in the County of  
Cambridge Cow Leach (that is to say) I give and devise  
unto my two sons Thomas Worland and Frederick Worland  
all that my Messuage or Tenement situate and being  
in Meldreth aforesaid wherein I now dwell together  
with the yards Gardens Orchards and appurtenances  
to the same belonging To hold to them my said two  
sons Thomas Worland and Frederic Worland their  
heirs and assigns for ever as tenants in common  
and not as joint tenants charged and chargeable  
nevertheless and I do hereby charge the same with  
the payment thereof of the sum of ten pounds

to my Daughter Mary Collins such sum of ten pounds  
to be paid to her within twelve months next after my  
decease I give and bequeath unto my said two Sons,  
Thomas and Frederick the Bedstead with feather Bed-  
bolster and pillows covered Blankets, Shirts and other  
appurtenances thereto belonging on which I usually sleep  
all the rest residue and remainder of my Household  
Goods and furniture horses carts Plate Linen China  
ready moneys and securities for money Book Debts  
and all other my personal estate and effects whatsoever  
and wheresoever, <sup>(G. S. W. S. H.)</sup> I give and bequeath, unto my two Sons  
William Worland and Charles Worland equally to be  
divided between them share and share alike they paying  
thereout all my just debts funeral expences and the  
charges of making and proving this my Will and  
lastly I nominate constitute and appoint my said  
two Sons William Worland and Charles Worland  
executors of this my Will and hereby revoking all former  
and other wills by me at any time heretofore made  
do declare this only to be and contain my last Will and  
testament In Witness whereof I the said Abbis Worland  
the Testator have hereunto set my hands this twenty  
fourth day of July in the year of our Lord One  
thousand eight hundred and thirty nine Abbis Worland  
Signed published and declared by the said Abbis  
Worland the Testator as and for his last Will and  
Testament in the presence of us who in his presence  
at his request and in the presence of each other have  
subscribed our names as Witnesses thereto G. S. Wallis

March 4<sup>th</sup> 1840. Proved on the Oaths of  
William Worland and Charles Worland they verifying  
upon oath that the Goods and Chattels Rights and  
Credits which were late of the deceased Testator do  
not amount in value to the sum of £100 in due form  
of Law & that the said Testator died on the 18<sup>th</sup> Sept. 1839
